Complex targets 2015

Times Square puts on show to celebrate Phase 1 completion

GUESTS at the official opening of the Penang Times Square (PTS) Phase One project in George Town were treated to an impressive performance put up by the Fingerprints Chamber Choir.

The nine-member choir performed a medley of two songs which were the Ivory Properties Group and Penang Times Square theme songs without being accompanied by any musical instrument.

The group's a capella performance had guests snapping their fingers and tapping their feet to the lively tunes.

There was also a fashion show by models who showcased a range of fashionable clothing from Sunshine City which is the anchor tenant of the shopping mall.

Guests were also shown a slide presentation of the development of PTS.

PTS, an iconic RM1bil integrated development project by the Ivory Properties Group at Datuk Keramat Road in George Town, is expected to be fully completed by 2015.

Phase One comprises Birch The Plaza, condominium units and retail lots with Sunshine City as the anchor tenant.

Ivory's executive director Datuk Seri Nazir Ariff said Phase Two of the project — The Birch Regency condominium project — was scheduled to be completed at the end of this year.

He said work on Phase Three, comprising a cineplex, a 80,000-plus sq ft (7,432sq m) convention and exhibition hall that would be connected to a hotel to be built under Phase Four, would commence next year.

"The development, which will also see a unique Heritage and Cultural Centre being set up, will be completed by 2015," he said in his speech at the grand opening of the Penang Times Square.

Also present were Ivory Properties group managing director Datuk Low Eng Hook, state executive councillors, MPs and state assemblymen.
