

Time to be spirited on Oct 30

Loads of shills, thrills and chills are in store at Chin Ho Plaza (the square's open space) where the Halloween Kids Costume Contest and Halloween Hunt will take place from 8pm to 9pm and 9pm to 11pm respectively.

The hunt is open to those aged 16 above where they are required to look for clues and solve a mystery puzzle.

Each team should comprise between

three and five members who may be clad in "gory" costumes and at least one member must be dressed for the occasion.

Entries can be submitted to the square's information counter by Oct 26.

The top three teams will receive RM1,000, RM688 and RM388 cash prizes respectively as well as Cititel vouchers. There will also be a Best Halloween Costume prize of RM388 plus Cititel vouchers while all participants will be given a free Marrybrown voucher worth RM20.

Kids aged 12 and below can also

dress up in their "goriest" outfits and have lots of fun in the costume contest.

All they have to do is to strut their stuff on stage and get a chance to bag the top three prizes comprising trophies and toys. Entries must also be submitted by Oct 26.

Another highlight will be a showcase of small capacity motorbikes by members of Penang Kap Chai, stalls selling merchandises and reptile pets and also a free face-painting booth between 8pm and midnight.
